BY-LAW NUMBER 2021-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to exempt Lots 21 and 22, Plan 1358; S/T RO232496, being all of PIN 58811-0044, in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe, from Part Lot Control imposed by Section 50(5) of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13.*

WHEREAS Section 50, Subsection 7 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13* provides that, notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection 5, the Council of a municipality may by by-law provide that plans of subdivision or parts of them are designated in the by-law are not subject to Subsection 5 of Section 50;

AND WHEREAS Simcoe County Housing Corporation has applied to the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie requesting that a by-law be enacted under the provisions of Subsection 7 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13*;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie adopted Motion 12-G-190;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to pass a by-law pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 7 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13* to exempt Lots 21 and 22, Plan 1358; S/T RO232496, being all of PIN 58811-0044, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts the following:

- 1. **THAT** Subsection 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13* does not apply to Lots 21 and 22, Plan 1358; S/T RO232496, being all of PIN 58811-0044, City of Barrie, County of Simcoe.
- 2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.
