To whom it may concern regarding the public meeting for 108, 116, 122 Harvie Road.

I would like to register to attend the public meeting however I am not able to provide oral comments at the time of the meeting and would like to submit the following written comment:

Overall I am excited for the extension of Beacon Road to alleviate the delay of trying to turn left onto Veterans Road however it does raise concerns regarding the additional traffic in the area. After reviewing the traffic impact study I noticed that in section 5.6 Beacon Road Traffic Calming it is recommended that the City consider installing a speed control device on Beach Road between Montserrand Street and Essa Road. I wanted to write in to get input from the City as to whether this is being reviewed and what the City is proposing. As a resident on Montserrand Street I already notice cars driving too fast, especially given the proximity to the playground. People use this street to get around traffic at the Veterans and Essa intersection. While this proposed Beacon extension will hopefully help alleviate some traffic on Montserrand Street, my concern is that people will continue to speed through this neighbourhood. Given that this proposed development, along with the proposed development at 339 Veteran's Drive & 341 Veteran's Lane, will most likely increase the number of children using Montserrand Park, I would ask that the City consider speed control devices on Montserrand Street as well as Beacon Road. Over the past couple of years we have had one temporary speed bump installed however it wasn't sufficient to slow traffic before they reached the park area as it was located in the middle of the park space. Please take this into consideration as these proposals are further developed and approved.
