
City of Barrie Community Safety and Well-Being Plan

LEGISLATION

The Province has legislated municipalities develop and adopt Community Safety and Well-Being Plans.

CSWB Plans shall:

- identify risk factors that contribute to crime, victimization, addiction, drug overdose and suicide;
- identify what risk factors the municipality will treat as priorities to reduce;
- identify actions to reduce the prioritized risk factors; and
- set out measurable outcomes that the actions are intended to produce.


BPS Community Safety and Well-Being Successes

ALL CRIMES ARE NOT EQUAL








Crime by Volume

- * "Hot Spots" (towers) reflect areas of concentrated crime




Crime by Harm




The higher the tower the greater the harm of the individual crimes

Crime by Volume




Crime by Harm



- Deploying officers where they are most needed








