TRIBUTE TO ROBERT WARMAN, MEMBER OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE

The Committee discussed his remarkable career serving with the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, the Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF) Military Police, Air Force Policeman.

BARRIE INTERNATIONAL PARTNERS WEBSITE UPDATE

Dave Morrison, Chair provided an update concerning the Barrie International Partners Website. He advised that a presentation will be taking place at a City Council meeting in March, 2022 concerning the launch of the Barrie International Partners Website.

MURAYAMA, JAPAN UPDATE

Mark Sachkiw and Hiromi Noguchi provided an update concerning Murayama, Japan. Mr. Sachkiw advised that he has received an interest from representatives in Murayama, Japan concerning a potential adult and youth exchange between the two municipalities in 2022.

YOUTH AMBASSADORS UPDATE

GERMAN TWINNING AND GERMAN CANADIAN CLUB UPDATE

He explained that Zweibrücken, Germany are preparing for a visit from the delegation from the City of Barrie during May, 2022 to commemorate the 25th Anniversary of the twinning relationship between the two municipalities. He advised that Zweibrücken, Germany will be hosting an anniversary celebration.

Mr. Pigeon explained that plans are for a delegation from Zweibrücken, Germany to visit the City of Barrie in September, 2022.

Mr. Pigeon advised that there is nothing new to report concerning the German Canadian Club.

HARROGATE, NORTH YORKSHIRE UNITED KINGDOM UPDATE

Bill Sergeant provided an update concerning Harrogate, North Yorkshire United Kingdom. He advised that there have been discussions concerning a potential exchange between Barrie Scouts and Air Cadets with Harrogate, England including virtual and in person exchanges.

Louise LeRoux explained that she is coordinating a meeting between the rugby clubs in Harrogate, England and Barrie to discuss a potential sports team exchange between the two municipalities.

ARRAS, FRANCE UPDATE

Dave Morrison, Chair advised that there were no updates concerning Arras, France.

SIR ROBERT BARRIE PROJECT UPDATE

Bill Sergeant provided an update concerning the Sir Robert Barrie Project including Sir Robert Barrie Day. Deputy Mayor Ward advised that he would contact staff in the Mayors Office to discuss Sir Robert Barrie Day for June 7, 2022.
