The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council with some information. Recreation and Culture staff are pleased to advise that after a 2-year period of openings and closings due to COVID 19, the Five Points Theatre, presented by Pratt Homes, Pratt Development Inc., and Georgian Theatre are back to hosting a full slate of activities.

Upcoming productions at the Five Points Theatre in the next several months include:

Theatre by the Bay has also booked the Five Points Theatre for 37 days for its upcoming productions. Further details on the dates of these productions will be provided once they are finalized.

Staff are also in the final stages of completing a new lease with Georgian College for use of their theatre. Until the lease is finalized, a temporary use permit has been put in place that allowed Miss Jennie's dance group to use the space on March 27, as well as future uses. Future uses at the Georgian Theatre include:

Multiple Dance Recitals and Competitions

The College has advised that it will continue to require Proof of Vaccination, screening, and masking in its buildings (including the Georgian Theatre) until April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022.

New to this year will be a pilot project using Eastview Arena to host a number of dance competitions and recitals. Staff have worked with the dance community to create a space to address their needs for performance space. The Eastview initiative will allow the City to expand our available space and better serve our growing community. This initiative will host six different dance groups over 10 days with more requests being accepted.
