

#### What is Business & Employer Data Survey?

- It is a detailed survey of all businesses within the employment and commercial areas of the City of Barrie.
- The survey is conducted by a team of 5 summer staff visiting businesses and organizations to gather key business and employment information.
- The purpose is to provide City staff with a comprehensive data set of businesses and sectors in Barrie.



### What is the Survey Area?


- Students visited businesses and organizations in employment and commercial areas across Barrie
- Over 4,300 were visited with a 72% response rate
- Home based businesses were not surveyed (they can selfidentify through online survey platform)





## Why is the Business Data Survey Important?

- Provides the City of Barrie with robust and current data to support future decision making and gives valuable insights on the economic landscape and economic trends of this City.
- Many municipalities across Ontario conduct Business Data Surveys and use the information across their organizations.
- While other private directory services exist along with certain statistics and information from other data sources, this data can be dated, sector/business-size specific, or at too high of a level and not to the level and timeliness that the Business Data Survey provides

- All data was collected using ArcGIS Field Maps. By using GIS, business data can be combined with other existing data
- The 2021 Business Data Survey is available publicly using the platform called "Experience Builder"
- Full Business Directory is available through GIS Open Data




