WHEREAS; The World Health Organization (2006), the United Nations (2008), and the Canadian

Government (2017) have recognized Sickle Cell Disease (SCD) as a global public health priority and in order to raise awareness, designated the 19th day of June every

year as World Sickle Cell Day (WSCD); and

WHEREAS; The Sickle Cell Awareness Group of Ontario (SCAGO) recognizes SCD as an

increasingly important medical issue in the province; and

WHEREAS; Over 14 municipalities across Ontario and 3 Canadian landmarks (CN Tower, Niagara

Falls and CNE) will be illuminated to celebrate WSCD and bring awareness to the

disease; and

WHEREAS; Through education and awareness programs, SCAGO is doing its part to reduce the

stigma and discrimination faced by the families with children, youth and adults living

with Sickle Cell Disease.
