PROCLAMATION

I, ALEX NUTTALL, Mayor of the City of BARRIE,

do hereby proclaim

November 17, 2022

as

Pancreatic Cancer Day

- WHEREAS;** In 2022, an estimated 6,700 people will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in Canada and 90 percent will eventually die from the disease; and
- WHEREAS;** Pancreatic cancer has the lowest survival rate of all major cancers, and just 10 percent of those diagnosed survive five years or longer; and
- WHEREAS;** Pancreatic cancer is the now the third leading cause of cancer related death in Canada; and
- WHEREAS;** It is estimated that by 2025, 550,000 new cases will be diagnosed globally; and
- WHEREAS;** The good health and well-being of the residents of Barrie are enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about the risks and symptoms of pancreatic cancer, and research into early detection, causes, and effective treatments.
- THEREFORE,** I, Alex Nuttall, Mayor of the City of Barrie, do hereby proclaim **November 17, 2022** as "**Pancreatic Cancer Day**" in the City of Barrie.
