RE: BRADFORD STREET CORRIDOR STUDY – NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE NO. 3 AND INVITATION FOR COMMENT (WARDS 2 AND 8)

The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council advance notice of the third Public Information Centre (PIC) for the Bradford Street Corridor Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) scheduled for Tuesday, December 13, 2022.

Following recommendations contained within the City's Transportation Master Plan, the City is undertaking this EA to identify long-range multi-modal transportation and streetscape improvements to support planned growth. The study is focusing on two specific areas: the Bradford Street corridor and the intersections of Tiffin Street/Bradford Street and Tiffin Street/Lakeshore Drive. The third PIC will present the preliminary design plan for the Bradford Street corridor, Tiffin Street intersections and next steps.

To advise the directly affected public of the PIC, a letter will be mailed on November 30, 2022, to agencies, businesses, property owners, and tenants in the area. To ensure Council has the same information as the public, this memo includes a copy of the mailout information.


