Our Painswick Library celebrated its 11th Anniversary on March 11, 2023. But this project has not yet been completed! When built 11 years ago - 2012 - the remaining area was to be developed as a green park. Our Painswick Horticultural Society planted the first mature oak tree on the edge of what is to be the park.

We at the Terraces have been known to be community minded since we first arrived on this block in 2001 - this was then a new neighbourhood!

We have been actively engaged in helping to better our neighbourhood.

We have worked with our councillors and city hall

- 1) to have traffic lights installed at our corner of Thadelaine and Dean
- 2) to have a bus shelter erected on our side of the street
- 3) to have our Painswick Library built down the street
- 4) to have the Pratt developer move their driveway closer to Yonge St., not directly across from ours
- 5) to have our next door developer move their driveway closer to the library entrance, not at our fence

We now have the opportunity, once again, to help make our walkable neighbourhood more appealing.

We are using our collective voice with our signatures and letter to request that our long overdue Painswick Library park be a priority for development in 2023!
