The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council with an update concerning key programming, rentals, and special event activities taking place during the month of July. The calendar in Appendix 'A' represents a summary of larger planned events taking place throughout our many recreation and cultural venues next month.

July's summer weather provides the perfect opportunity for the City's outdoor facilities to come alive with activity and it starts with the bang of Canada Day fireworks on July 1st. As this is a Saturday, the expectation will be larger-than-average crowds enjoying the celebrations in Barrie's downtown and on the waterfront.

Meridian Place will continue to be a buzz of activity throughout the month with weekly salsa dance classes on Tuesdays and Lawnchair Luminata on Wednesdays. Automotive enthusiasts can take a walk back in time at the Barrie Thunder Classics at Heritage Park also on Wednesdays.

Our sports fields will play host to a variety of tournaments including baseball, soccer, slo-pitch, and football. The Barrie Baycats will host four games at Vintage Throne Stadium in July. Visit Maitland Park on July 29th to enjoy a game of cricket.

The Five Points Theatre will host the Simcoe County Theatre Festival from July 12th to 23rd while Georgian Theatre hosts tribute performances to Elvis and Frankie Valli.

Summer camps for children aged 5 - 13 years old will begin after Canada Day weekend. Over 5,400 registrations have been received for our popular Base Camps, Kinder Fun Camps, Earth Challenge Camps or Sport Camps offered throughout various City parks and Community Centres. This represents a 28% increase over 2022 registrations.

The calendar in Appendix A represents only a portion of the programs and activities offered to City of Barrie residents and non-residents alike, many of which can be found at Recreation Programs | City of Barrie. The dedication, commitment, and professionalism of the department's full-time and part-time staff can often be seen in the expressions of the many City of Barrie residents and visitors who participate.
