Affected services during the Labour Day holiday in Barrie

(Barrie, ON) - The following municipal services will be affected due to the Labour Day holiday on Monday, September 4.

Barrie Transit

Barrie Transit will operate according to the Sunday service schedule on September 4. To plan your trip, visit MyRideBarrie.ca.

Curbside Collection

There will be no garbage, organics, recycling and yard waste collection on September 4 in Barrie. Collection will occur one day later throughout the rest of the week. Materials must be curbside by 7 a.m. on your collection day. View your collection day via barrie.ca/CurbsideCollection.

Recreation/Community Centres

Barrie's recreation and community centres will be closed on September 4.

City Hall

Barrie City Hall will be closed on September 4.

Parking

Downtown parking (on-street and lots) is not enforced on statutory holidays. Waterfront parking is enforced 24/7/365. To park free in select waterfront areas, vehicles must be registered with a digital waterfront parking permit, or display a hangtag waterfront parking pass. Vehicles without a pass or permit are required to pay \$10/hour (daily maximum: \$50). Visit barrie.ca/parking for details.

Reminder: Fireworks are not permitted on Labour Day holiday weekend

Fireworks cannot be set off on the Labour Day holiday or surrounding days. Fireworks can only be set off on the following (single calendar) days: Victoria Day, Canada Day, New Year's Day, and for the duration of the recognized Lunar New Year and Diwali holidays, as per the <u>Regulatory Matters By-law</u>.
