



Muriel and A.J. Billes Family Playground Now Open in Painswick Park

The City of Barrie, Canadian Tire Jumpstart Charities, and the Canadian Tire Dealers' Association open inclusive play space for kids of all abilities

Barrie, ON (September 7, 2023) – The City of Barrie, Canadian Tire Jumpstart Charities (Jumpstart), and the Canadian Tire Dealers' Association (CTDA) celebrated the grand opening of the *Muriel and A.J. Billes Family Playground* today in Painswick Park, with more than 120 local kids onsite to experience the universally accessible play space.

Named in honour of Canadian Tire Corporation's (CTC) founding family, the *Muriel and A.J. Billes Family Playground* is a tribute to the Billes family in celebration of the company's 100th anniversary. The stateof-the-art facility was made possible thanks to generous donations from Canadian Tire's nearly 500 store owners across the country, whose total contributions to the project exceed \$2 million.

"On behalf of our 500 Associate Dealers, the Canadian Tire Dealers' Association is honoured to present the *Muriel and A.J. Guided by universal design principles, the 21,000-square-foot inclusive playground enables kids of all ages and abilities to play side-by-side. The new play space is the largest of its kind built as part of Jumpstart's *Inclusive Play Project*, which focuses on removing accessibility barriers to sport and play.

"Thanks to the generous contributions of the Canadian Tire Dealers' Association, kids of all ages and abilities will have greater access to joys of inclusive play in Barrie," said Nadir Patel, Chairman of the Board, Canadian Tire Jumpstart Charities. "With the opening of the *Muriel and A.J. Billes Family Playground*, we are proud to monumentalize Martha Billes' extensive impact on youth sport and recreation."

Already a community hub for recreation, the new playground is a complement to the recent redevelopments at Painswick Park led by the City of Barrie, which include the addition of eight pickleball courts, three baseball diamonds, and new lit pathways.
