Motion for Consideration:

That Traffic By-law 2020-107, Schedule 1, "No Parking Anytime" be amended by deleting:

"Quance Street The east side of Mapleton Drive to a point of 54 metres south thereof."

Reason or Rationale in support of the motion:

Pre 2016 a no parking By-law was adopted on Quance to not permit parking within 54M of the intersection with Mapleton due to complaints pre 2016. Back in 2016 a previous Councillor had advised the resident that he was moving the no parking signs as it was no longer an issue and the complainant had moved. The residents have provided a petition signed by the 10 residents most effected by this no parking area. The Clerks Office have also provided email evidence of the 2016 emails between the previous Councillor and the Clerks office where he advised that he wasn't going to proceed however never advised the resident of such. In recent months this has become a real issue as the city replaced the no parking sign three times and each time it has been removed by a resident. This motion is to fix this matter that should've been completed in 2016.
