Ontario Works: \$4.7M (+\$684K)

- Projected 2024 caseload is 5,702
- Caseload shifts result in a 0.2% decrease to the County, a 1.5% increase to the City of Barrie, and a 1.3% decrease to the City of Orillia
- Provincial Employment Assistance/Life Stabilization funding decreasing by \$2.6M in 2024 (CCW 2023-160)
- Provincial funding for administration continues to be capped at 2018 spending level

Children Services: \$1.95M (+\$0)

- 2024 budget is based on the 2023 Ministry of Education allocations, with an increase in the Canada Wide Early Learning and Child Care program to account for the next increase in funding slated for September 2024
- \$671K transfer from reserve to offset Barrie, Orillia, & County budget increase in 2024. These reserve funds were prior year municipal savings that were a result of the transitional grants (2021-2023), placed in reserve to offset future budget increases
- Space rental costs for the 3rd floor of the Barrie satellite office transferred to Children Services from Ontario Works (\$348K)
