The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council with an update concerning key programming, rentals, and special event activities taking place during the month of February. The calendar in Appendix 'A' represents a summary of larger planned events taking place throughout our many recreation and cultural venues next month.

February comes alive with a celebration of winter! Hello Winter events take place throughout the month to highlight the many winter activities available to residents and visitors alike. Winterfest kicks things off the first weekend of the month with events located around Heritage Park and Meridian Place. On February 19th, Family Day events will take place at the Barrie Community Sports Complex with activities in the snow and on the ice. Last year, over 2,000 residents attended this annual event.

February is also a celebration of Black History and there are many events taking place around the City showcasing the history of Black culture both within Barrie and the wider community and it all begins with a ceremonial flag raising at City Hall on February 1st.

Both the Five Points and Georgian theatres host a selection of productions by local theatre groups including the "First Metis Man of Odesa" by Talk is Free Theatre and "Lost Heroes of Oro" by Infinity Performing Arts Studio.

The City's arenas play host to several tournaments this month. Family Day weekend will be the busiest with Barrie Ringette's Tournament at the Allandale and Peggy Hill Team centres while BWHA's annual Sharkfest Winter Classic will take place at the East Bayfield and Peggy Hill Team centres.

Hockey Helps the Homeless will be held on February 29th and March 1st with a Thursday evening event at Southshore Centre followed by hockey games played on Friday at Peggy Hill Team Community Centre. Details can be found at 2024 Hockey Helps the Homeless.
