### Motion for Consideration:

1. That notwithstanding Pool Enclosure By-law 94-59 an exemption be provided to 28 Royal Oak Drive to construct a pool enclosure fence along the two residential sides of the property with no fencing to be installed along the waterfront access, where as the by-law provides for the pool to be fully enclosed on three sides of the property; and
2. That owner must comply with all other provisions of the Pool Enclosure By-law.

### Reason or Rationale in support of the motion:

The current bylaw doesn't speak to any special provisions for waterfront properties and having a fence block off a water access point does very little from a safety perspective. Staff noted they will be reviewing the by-law provisions at some point, but until that time this property would need an exemption.
