The purpose of this Memorandum is to provide members of Council with an update concerning key programming, rentals, and special event activities taking place during the month of March. The calendar in Appendix 'A' represents a summary of larger planned events taking place throughout our many recreation and cultural venues next month.

The Five Points and Georgian theatres host a selection of productions by local theatre groups including the final two performances of "First Metis Man of Odesa" by Talk is Free Theatre and musical performances such as GoldiRocks, Floydium, and Lennon Live. Several dance competitions take place in both theatres during the month. More information on these shows plus ticket purchases is available at <u>TicketPro</u>.

Sadlon Arena will host 6 Barrie Colts games as the Colts continue battling for a playoff berth. On March 3rd, Colts players will excite young fans by participating in the annual Colt for the Day event. The Colts will also host March Break hockey camps at Sadlon Arena from the 13th to the 15th. Finally, the Harlem Globetrotters will bring exciting family entertainment to Barrie on March 18th with their usual style of fun-filled basketball play.

Hockey Helps the Homeless will be held on February 29th and March 1st with a Thursday evening event at Southshore Centre followed by hockey games played on Friday at Peggy Hill Team Community Centre. Details can be found at 2024 Hockey Helps the Homeless.

March will also feature several special events including Barrie Police Services' Polar Plunge in support of Special Olympics, Easter-themed vendor markets, two events at Southshore Community Centre celebrating Persian cultural heritage, and a march in the downtown area in support of International Women's Day.
