**BY-LAW NUMBER 2024-**

**A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to further amend Business Licensing By-law 2006-266 (General Licensing) regarding the Downtown Business Improvement Area (BIA) patio program season.**

**WHEREAS** Section 8 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, provides that powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 9 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising the authority under the Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 10 (1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* provides a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

**AND WHEREAS** by motion 24-A-043, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to enact a by-law to further regulate and define the Downtown Business Improvement Area (BIA) patio program season.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Business Licensing By-law 2006-266 be further amended to add Schedule "A" – Downtown Business Improvement Area (BIA) Patio Program Season.
2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 19<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2024.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 19<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2024.
