As you know that the Cenotaph's and grounds need a upgrade long overdue, so that all the names of those who gave their lives for freedom of our country in the First, Second, World Wars, Korea and Peace Keepers and the present conflict in the world.

I have contacted various monumental firms and have found that SANDERSONS MONUMENT COMPANY FROM ORILLIA have the best qualifications for the job, after viewing numerous Cenotaphs of their work I feel they are most qualified and their work will last for twenty five years or more.

Besides the CENOTAPHS the grounds need uplifting, such as the removal of the Lilac Bush and maybe the Fir Tree that has grown into the light beside to another area of the Garden.

The cost to refurbish the Cenotaph's is around the Ten Thousand Dollar figure ., Prorated and shared with Innisfil and Spring water on a basis of numbers of the ones who gave their lives for our freedom., a total of 155 (One Hundred and Fifty Five).


One Hundred and Three from Barrie... Forty One from Innisfil and Eleven from Springwater, Based on the cost per Veteran of Sixty Five Dollars (\$65.00) per Veteran who gave their lives Barrie's cost is \$6,695.00) SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED AND NINETY FIVE DOLLARS including all taxes.

I am contacting the other municipalities and also have had contact with VETERANS AFFAIRS, and hope that maybe the Citizens of Barrie will also contribute to this worthy cause.

Should there be a excess of funds from the public a bank account will be opened to be held in trust by the city of Barrie for future needs, to keep the Memorial area in a excellent condition at all times in the future.

However I feel that the three Municipalities should bear the initial cost, I am prepared to meet with all Council members A.S.P. so the work can and will be completed before November Eleven (REMEMBERANCE DAY) 2011.
