



BY-LAW NUMBER 2011-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to further amend By-law 80-138, as amended, being a By-law to regulate traffic on highways.

WHEREAS Section 8 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, ("the Municipal Act, 2001") provides that the powers of a municipality under this or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on the municipality to enable the municipality to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS Section 9 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, provides that a single-tier municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public, *inter alia* highways;

AND WHEREAS by motion 11-G-169 and 11-G-192 it is deemed expedient that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie amend By-law 80-138 as amended, being a by-law to regulate traffic on highways;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** By-law 80-138, "**Schedule "A" – No Parking Anytime**" be amended by adding the following in alphabetical order:

"Miller Drive

West Side from Edgehill Drive north to northern City limits"

2. **THAT** By-law 80-138, "**Schedule "B", No Parking in Specified Places Where Signs on Display at Stated Times**" be amended by adding the following:

"Grace Crescent from Raquel Street to Shaina Court

North Side

**8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Monday to Friday,
September 1st to July 1st,"**

3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a third time and finally passed this 27th day of June, 2011.
