

BY-LAW NUMBER 2012-

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to amend By-law 2006-265 as amended being a by-law to license, regulate and govern transportation related businesses carried on within the municipality.

WHEREAS, Section 8 of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, ("the *Municipal Act*, 2001") provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Act;

AND WHEREAS, Section 9 of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that Sections 8 and 11 shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to (a) enable municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and, (b) enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues;

AND WHEREAS, Section 11, of the *Municipal Act*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, provides that a singletier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Barrie passed By-law 2006-265 on October 30, 2006 being a by-law to licence, regulate and govern transportation related businesses carried on within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Motion 12-G-151 the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to further amend By-law 2006-265.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** By-law 2006-265, Section 9.3.7.0.0 <u>"Taxi Tariff Rates and Fares"</u> be deleted and replaced with the following:
 - **"9.3.7.0.0** A 10% discount shall be provided on any cash fare to any person providing proof of senior citizenship by producing a federally issued Senior Citizens card and the fare be rounded up or down to the nearest \$0.05 increment."
- 2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time 27th day of August, 2012.

READ a third time and finally passed this 27th day of August 2012.
