BY-LAW NUMBER 2012

A By-law of The Corporation of the City of Barrie amend By-law 2011-007 to appoint members to the Accessibility Advisory Committee

WHEREAS, The Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 32 was enacted to improve opportunities for persons with disabilities and to provide for their involvement in the identification, removal and prevention of barriers to their full participation in the life of the province;

AND WHEREAS, The Ontarians with Disabilities Act provides that the Council of every municipality having a population of not less than 10,000 shall establish or continue an Accessibility Advisory Committee and the Council of every municipality having a population of less than 10,000 may establish or continue an Accessibility Advisory Committee;

AND WHEREAS, the Accessibility Advisory Committee shall advise the Council in each year about the preparation, implementation and effectiveness of its accessibility plan;

AND WHEREAS, by motion 12-G-199, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to amend By-law 2011-007 with respect to the appointment of members to the Accessibility Advisory Committee.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Councillor D. Shipley be appointed to the Accessibility Advisory Committee to serve in Councillor J. Robinson's capacity on the Accessibility Advisory Committee until such time as the appointments of members of Council to Committee/boards for 2013/2014 are considered.
- 2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.
