There were certain folks, at that time who were very concerned about the heights requested from Mr. Rutledge (14 stories for The bay Club and 11 stories for the office building). These heights were unheard of in Barrie.

The council looked at the vision of these plans and approved them.

For a large number of reason including tax based positives a twenty story building in Barrie's downtown will be less than average in the next decade or two. The development of this building will lead, very shortly, to other similar developments in the central core of Barrie. Please do not scare this development off.

Please look into the future and do not miss this opportunity for downtown redevelopment.
