



**BY-LAW NUMBER 2018-**

**A Bylaw of The Corporation of the City of Barrie to assume lands described as Dunn Street, Plan 51M-778 being all of PIN 58729-1136 (LT) for public use and to accept the “as constructed” municipal services within and complimentary to the Dunn Street Subdivision described as 51M-788.**

**WHEREAS** Section 10 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended (the “Municipal Act, 2001”), provides that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters set out therein including, inter alia public assets of the municipality acquired for the purpose of exercising its authority under the Municipal Act, 2001 or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie deems it expedient to assume lands described as Dunn Street, Plan 51M-778 being all of PIN 58729-1136 (LT), in the City of Barrie, County of Simcoe as shown on Schedule “A” attached;

**AND WHEREAS** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie passed Motion 11-G-276 delegating authority to the Director of Engineering to accept the municipal infrastructure within Plans of Subdivision;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of The Corporation of the City of Barrie enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** all of the road described as Dunn Street, on Plan 51M-778, being all of PIN 58729-1136 (LT) as shown on Schedule “A” attached be assumed for public use.
2. **THAT** the “as-constructed” municipal services within and complementary to the Dunn Street subdivision Registered as Plan 51M-778 as shown on Schedule “A” attached be accepted.
3. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and have effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2018.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2018.
