RVH gets a unanimous "yes" from Barrie City Council

Barrie's city council has unanimously endorsed one of the province's largest financial commitments ever made to a hospital from a municipality.



- Project will double the size of hospital
 - 440,000 sq. feet of new space
 - 100,000 sq. feet of renovations in existing building


July 2011

Total price tag for expansion is \$450 million

- Capacity for 165 new in-patient beds
- Dedicated Coronary Care Unit
- Expanded Emergency Department
- Expanded Laboratory

Phase 1 Expansion

- Expanded Diagnostic Imaging Department
- 2 new Operating Suites
- Simcoe Muskoka Regional Cancer Centre



- 40 different trades represented
- 80% of trades people are local






Emergency Department

The Cancer Centre will log over 65,000 patient visits in its first year



















The "I Believe" campaign has almost reached its \$35 million goal.
