The Seniors Advisory Committee met and reports as follows:

2020 WORK PLAN

D. Dello, Chair discussed the work plan and goals with the Committee for 2020. The Committee agreed to focus on ways to overcome accessibility, affordable housing for seniors, aging in place and the diverse needs of seniors.

Ms. Dello discussed potential presentations for 2020 from City Departments and outside organizations to gather statistics and information associated to seniors such as population, food security, health services, daily living expenses and income levels. C. Dillon, Accessibility and Diversity Advisor and J. Gourlie, Recreation Programmer provided suggestions and resources to gather the information. The Committee agreed to focus on seniors housing for the January, 2020 meeting.
