BRIEF STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF THE OPEN DELEGATION: Tyndale Park has become a very popular beach for Barrie Residents and Out-of-town visitors which has resulted in well documented overcrowding. This beach also hosts Barrie City Day Camps in July & August at which time half the beach is cordoned off. The 2020 City of Barrie Camps scheduled at Tyndale Park were cancelled due to COVID 19. However, 2021 City of Barrie camps are scheduled to resume and the city needs to address whether priority will be given to securing this beach for Barrie City camps and Barrie residents, or whether it will be continue to be shared with to out-of-town visitors. The beach area is roughly the size of an average backyard when half the beach is consumed by Barrie City camps, and does not have the capacity to safely host all 3 groups and still remain enjoyable and safe for Barrie residents.
