COMMITTEE BUDGET UPDATE

YOUTH AMBASSADORS UPDATE

Dave Morrison, Chair provided details concerning the Global Perspectives program and the past financial support provided by the Committee for events, such as youth delegation goodbye parties. That the Committee approved an expenditure of funds from the International Relations Committee budget #1026 660200 for the Global Perspectives program of up to \$2,000.00 in an effort to support and to maintain the existing international relationship initiatives.

Mr. Morrison acknowledged Jeff Toole and Jamie Babcock for their extraordinary work maintaining the Global Perspectives program for students at Innisdale Secondary School during the COVID-19 pandemic and travel ban.
