PRESENTATION BY COUNCILLOR B. WARD AND GRAEME KING, MANAGER OF FACILITY PLANNING OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR'S ONTARIO HERITAGE AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN CONSERVATION FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE FORMER ALLANDALE STATION

Councillor, B. Ward and Graeme King, Manager of Facility Planning presented Mayor Lehman with the 2014 Lieutenant Governor's Ontario Heritage Award for the restoration of the Allandale Train Station.
